THE MEETING: The meeting was conducted as a Zoom hybrid. Selectboard members Rich Donaldson, Jon Collins, and administrator, Amanda Campbell, were together in the Town Office. Bronwen Tudor was on Zoom. There were 7 members of the public in attendance on Zoom.

MOST IMPORTANT/INTERESTING ITEMS: In my judgment, the following items were the most important things covered during the meeting.

- The proposed Solar Energy Ordinance came back from the Planning Board and was approved by the Selectboard for inclusion at the upcoming Ordinance Hearing in May
- Georgetown Volunteer Fire Department budget planning was discussed at length. Answers to a list of questions submitted to the Fire Chief are expected in advance of the next Selectboard meeting
- TOPMB and Recreation Committee have agreed to an assignment of expenses and responsibilities
- The Sagadahoc County Hazard Mitigation Plan was approved
- Peter Kruze was appointed to the Harbor Committee
- The Town Clerk has submitted the Election & Ballot Clerk list to the Selectboard as required
- Budget and Ordinance Hearings in May will be virtual on Zoom. Details TBA
- Town Meeting will be moderated by John Cunningham. No decision yet on inside or outside. Planning for both possibilities is ongoing
