The Meeting: The meeting was conducted as a Zoom hybrid. Selectboard Members Selectboard Members Jon Collins and Aria Eee, and Town Administrator Tyler Washburn were together in the Town Office. Selectboard Member Bronwen Tudor was on Zoom. There were 15 members of the public in attendance in person or on Zoom.

The minutes of the meeting of July 9, 2024 were approved. They will be posted on the Town website.

Most Important/Interesting Items: In my judgment, the following items were the most important things covered during the meeting.

- The Revised Fee Schedule was adopted with revisions after discussion, and input from the public during the 7pm Public Hearing on Proposed Fee Schedule Changes. The new fee schedule will be posted on the website soon
- Assessors, Bill Van Tuinen and Pat Dow, will soon begin pickup work and will be visiting properties
- The August 13th Selectboard meeting has been rescheduled to Tuesday, August 6th at 7pm
- The previously discussed Robinhood Road Streetlight will be moved, by CMP, to Pole 3 with shading and appropriate wattage
- Approval was granted for the hiring of a part time Transfer Station Attendant. This will not be an increase in scheduled workforce but is needed due to adjustments in current staff availability. The job will be posted

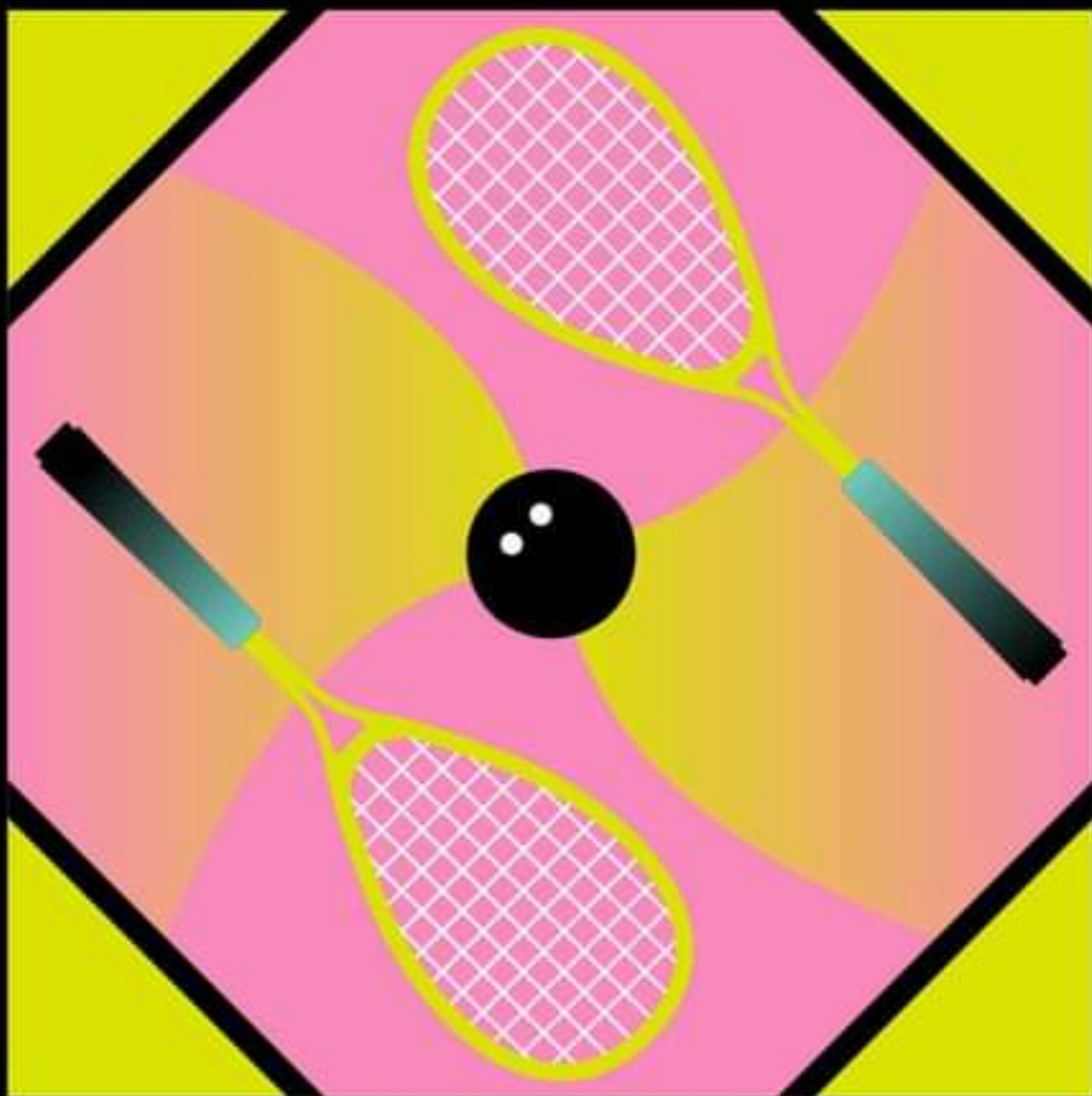
