<u>THE MEETING</u>: The meeting was conducted as a Zoom hybrid. Selectboard members Jon Collins and Town Administrator, Amanda Campbell, were together in the Town Office. Bronwen Tudor and Rich Donaldson were on Zoom. There were 15, members of the public in attendance on Zoom.

MOST IMPORTANT/INTERESTING ITEMS: In my judgment, the following items were the most important things covered during the meeting.

- The final report from the Energy Working Group was accepted
- The Selectboard agreed to join the Community Resilience Partnership during a scheduled appointment with the Conservation Commission (CC).

 There was much discussion regarding the choice between the two projects recommended by the CC for potential grant proposals. Project 1 is as described in the Georgetown Climate Resilience Grant Proposals Survey. Project 2 is a combination of projects 2, 3, & 4 as described in the survey. The Selectboard authorized the Conservation Commission to work on a grant proposal for Project 2 for possible submission for a no match grant in late September.
