THE MEETING: The meeting was conducted as a Zoom hybrid. Selectboard members Rich Donaldson and Jon Collins, and Town Administrator, Amanda Campbell, were together in the Town Office. Bronwen Tudor was on Zoom. There were 4 members of the public in attendance on Zoom.

The minutes of the meeting of September 13, 2022, were approved. They will be posted on the Town website.

MOST IMPORTANT/INTERESTING ITEMS: In my judgment, the following items were the most important things covered during the meeting.

- Jon Collins reported that he is working with CMP to inventory and remove dead trees in the roadway right-of-way to prevent blowdowns that could cause power outages or road closures. Homeowners may receive notifications about trees of concern that are outside the roadway right of way on private land
- A motion from Bronwen Tudor was approved to have Jon Collins get an estimate for redirecting water away from the foundation of First Church in an effort to protect the building from further water damage
- First Church – Amanda has a meeting scheduled with Senator King’s people for alternative funding source opportunities
- Harvest Potluck noon 10/8/2022 at the GCC
