THE MEETING: There were three members of the public present.

The minutes of the meeting of August 13 were approved.

CORRESPONDENCE:

The most interesting items were:

- A letter from the State Department of Transportation notifying the Town that we will receive \$6,316 less this fiscal year from the Local Road Assistance Program.
- A letter from the Sagadahoc County Administrative Office notifying the Town that the County Tax Levy for this fiscal year is \$828.907. This was what was expected and appropriated at Town Meeting in June. The amount comes due on September 1 with interest being assessed starting on November 1. Mary will pay this on October 31.
- A letter from United Way announcing a meeting on heating assistance and weatherization on October 8. Mary will attend and report any useful information she obtains.
- a memo from Cathy Collins, Town Clerk/Tax Collector, announcing that starting in September the Town Clerk/Tax Collector hours will go up to five days per week.
- - a memo from Cathy Collins, Town Clerk/Tax Collector, suggesting that it was unnecessary to post Public Election Notices at the Town Wharf and the Marina since there were very few people using these facilities at the times when elections are usually held. The Selectmen voted to end the postings at the Town Wharf and the Marina.

OLD BUSINESS

There was nothing to report regarding finding a new Town Office Gallery Director. Annie Merrill has offered her work for display starting in October. Kristin Malin's work will continue to be displayed through September.

Codes Enforcement Officer Jason Lang will follow up on the new letter to the Kosalkas regarding the agreement about violations at the Sagadahoc Campground. He will also continue to work with Mr. Martin on preparing an after the fact permit for an accessory structure. Mr. Martin has already paid the required fee to the Town.

There was no new business.

The next meeting of the Selectmen will be at 7 PM on Tuesday, September 10 at the Town Office.
