THE MEETING: There were 1 members of the public present. 3 additional people came to discuss specific issues (see below).

The minutes of the meeting of September 10, 2013 were approved.

MOST IMPORTANT/INTERESTING ITEMS: In my judgment, the following items were the most important things covered during the meeting.

George Jamieson came to discuss membership on the Shellfish Conservation Committee. After a discussion of responsibilities and his interest, the Board voted unanimously to appoint him to fill out the term of Robert Hasenfus through June 2014.

Eric and Patricia Kosalka came to discuss resolution of all the septic system issues detailed in a May letter initiated by the Board. This was an extensive discussion of details, ultimately leading to agreement between the Board and Kosalkas of exactly what additional actions and documentation will be accomplished. Once completed, these actions and documentation will put to bed all of the issues raised by Bob Trabona, CEO early this year.

Mary obtained a quote of \$1300 plus \$300/yr maintenance for the "Sketch" program which would be used to computerize assessment records. It was noted that there would also be a cost to convert existing records, most likely over time using some sort of internship. The Board asked that she propose it in next year's budget.

The Board approved Cathy Collins request to purchase a new computer/printer for the Town Clerk/Tax Collector. Note: This purchase was in the approved Town budget.
