**The Meeting:** The meeting was conducted as a Zoom hybrid. Selectboard Members Selectboard Members Jon Collins and Aria Ee, Town Administrator Tyler Washburn, and Finance Director Mary McDonald were together in the Town Office. 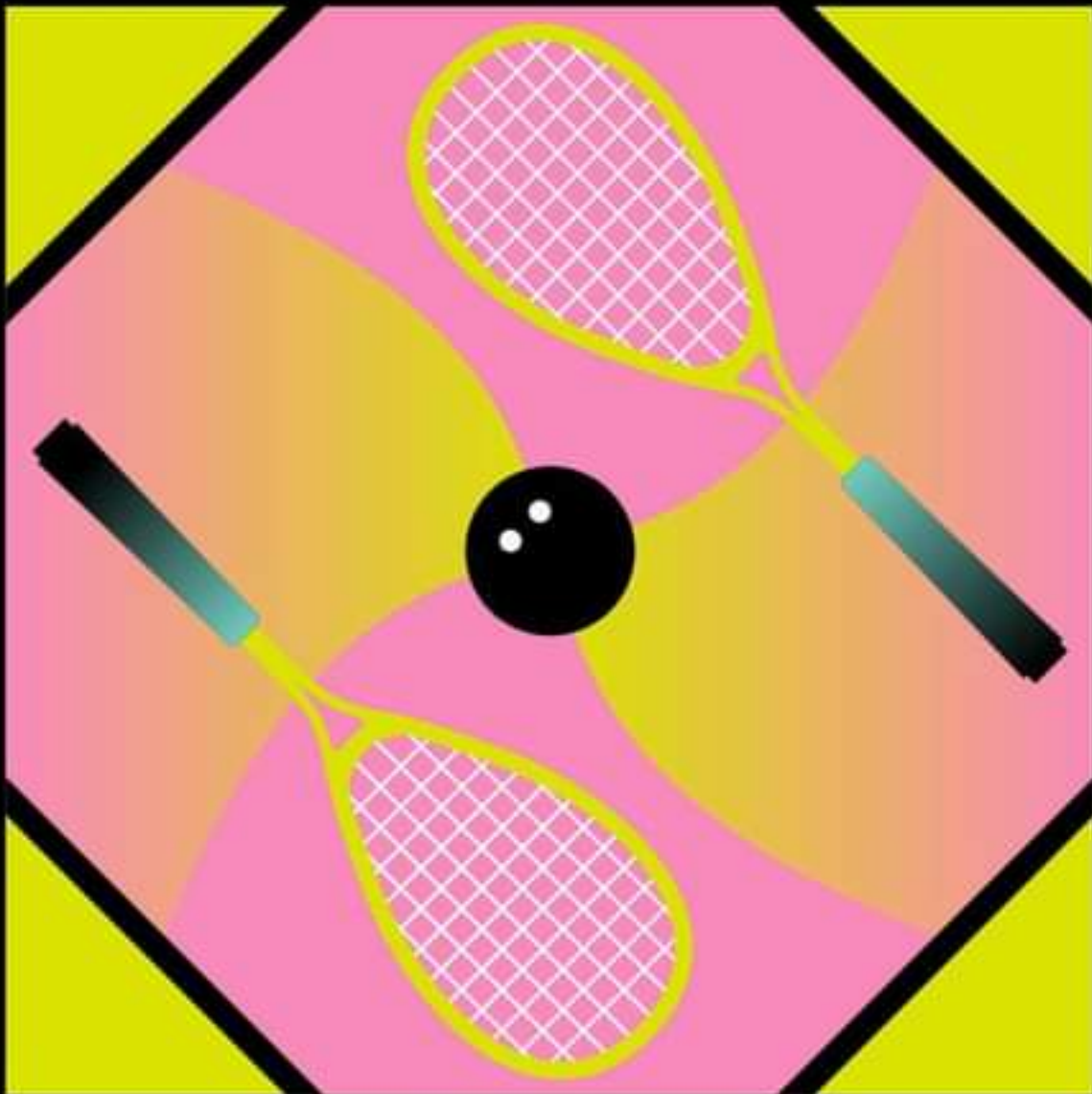
