OLD BUSINESS:

Mary McDonald reviewed an updated list of Board and Committee members for the Selectmen, This included a number of reappointments of members whose terms had expired.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. There was a response from Town Counsel regarding whether Kate MacKay could continue to serve as Animal Control Officer (ACO) since any complaints about the ACO are heard by the Selectmen. The Selectmen decided that MacKay could continue to serve as ACO while the Town sought a new person to serve as ACO.
2. There was a response from Town Counsel regarding a question from the Cemetery Trustees about their authority to regulate the placing of lights at grave sites under the Cemetery District Ordinance. The response was forwarded to the Trustees.
3. A request from the Community Center to close a portion of the Old Schoolhouse Road during Community Day on Saturday, July25, was approved.

The next meeting of the Selectmen will be at 7 PM on Tuesday, July 28, at the Town Office.
